So let us come and remember, and proclaim and eat.” – John Piper

The Lord’s Supper is for those who (1) in faith, have placed their trust in Jesus Christ for salvation and have accepted him as Lord, (2) have taken the first steps of obedience by being baptized, and (3) are in good standing with a Bible believing church, and (4) have sought forgiveness for their sins against God and others and have forgiven others their offenses against them.

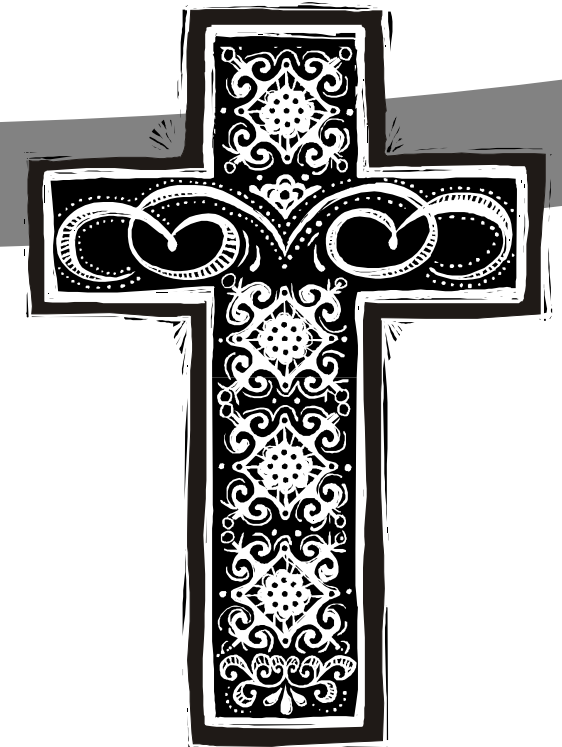
